Our Crowdfunding campaign to raise over £6,000 for new samba instruments and to deliver samba workshops in schools hit its target in December 2019. 70 amazing backers offered to support the project, adding their donations to a generous pledge from Arts Council England through the Our Music Crowd fund.

The Youth Samba band themselves put a huge amount of energy and enthusiasm into the campaign from brainstorming the fundraising opportunities with us and creating the promotional video through to playing and bag packing at Tescos to raise money. Together with band leader Dan Johnston they're looking forward to doubling the size of the band, playing on new, professional quality instruments and spreading the joy of samba to more young people in Sheffield.
